

# **Idaho FFA History**

- 1. The Idaho FFA Association holds State Charter No. 17 in the National Organization. It was issued on September 4, 1929.
- 2. A state charter was issued to the Idaho FFA Alumni Association by the National FFA Alumni on October 13, 1972.
- 3. Malad was the first chapter chartered in the Idaho FFA Association.
- 4. The first State President of the Idaho FFA Association was Rodney Hansen, from Firth, in 1929-1930.
- 5. Idaho's first State FFA Advisor was William Kerr.
- 6. Idaho's first American FFA Degree recipient was Carrol Baker, from Twin Falls, in 1928.



- 7. In 1928, three students from Twin Falls attended the first National FFA Convention held in Kansas City, Missouri, at the Baltimore Hotel.
- 8. These are the first fifteen chapters chartered in the Idaho FFA Association in 1929:

- 9. Ten FFA members received their Idaho State FFA Degree the first year it was issued in 1930. In 2019, 270 Idaho FFA members received their State FFA Degree.
- 10. Fifty-four Idaho FFA members have been selected as National FFA Proficiency Award Finalists.

# **National FFA History**

- 13. The FFA Creed was written by E. M. Tiffany in 1930. KNOW THE CREED!
- 14. The first National FFA President was Leslie Applegate.
- 15. FFA began in Kansas City, Missouri, in 1928.
- 16. Original National FFA dues were \$0.10.
- 17. The Smith-Hughes Act established Vocational Agriculture in 1917.
- 18. African American males were welcomed to the FFA in 1965.
- 19. Women were welcomed to the FFA in 1969, and 2019 is the 50 year anniversary of this decision.
- 20. Sitting US Presidents who have addressed the National FFA Convention in person include:

- 21. FFA officially changed its name to the National FFA Organization in 1988.
- 22. The first FFA Manual was published in 1930, in Pennsylvania.

- 30. Idaho FFA Association membership for 2018-2019 school year totaled 5,208 members.
- 31. State and National FFA Membership dues are \$16.00, and include the following: \$7.00 for National FFA dues (including the National FFA Magazine, New Horizons) \$9.00 for State FFA Association dues
  - \*\*\$2.00 of the \$9.00 State Association dues go to the Idaho FFA Foundation to grow a long-term endowment and support Idaho FFA Foundation operations.

# Idaho FFA Dates and Deadlines

- 32. The 2020 State FFA Leadership Conference will be held April 1-4, 2020, at the College of Southern Idaho in Twin Falls, Idaho.
- 33. Chapter Rosters and Programs of Activities (POA) are due to the State FFA Office December 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- 34. Each chapter's Annual FFA Report is due online June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- 35. State Proficiency applications are due postmarked to the State FFA Office by March 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 36. State Officer Candidate applications are due postmarked to the State FFA Office by February 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 37. American FFA Degree applications are due online to the State FFA Office March 1st.
- 38. National Chapter Award applications are due postmarked to State FFA Office, Attention: Lucas Barnett by March 1st.
- 39. State FFA Career Development Events (State CDEs) will be held June 2-5, 2020, at the University of Idaho in Moscow.

#### IDAHO FFA ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION INFORMATION

- 60. The Idaho FFA Association Board of Directors has the power to make Association decisions and oversee the operation of the Idaho FFA Association
  - a. Members include
    - i. Six (6) constitutional officers
    - ii. Ten (10) District Directors of the IVATA
    - iii. IATA president, president elect and past president
    - iv. One (1) representative of the Idaho FFA Alumni Association
    - v. One (1) representative of the Idaho FFA Foundation
    - vi. One (1) teacher educator representing the Department of Agriculture Education and Extension Education at the University of Idaho
    - vii. One (1) past state FFA officer
    - viii. State FFA Advisor (ex-officio)
    - ix. State FFA Executive Director (ex-officio)
- 61. The Constitutional Officers of the Idaho FFA Association are:
  - a. President
  - b. Vice President
  - c. Secretary
  - d. Treasurer
  - e. Reporter
  - f. Sentinel
- 62. The three kinds of membership shall be:
  - a. Active
  - b. Alumni
  - c. Honorary
- 63. The emblem of the FFA shall be made up of five symbols:
  - a. Plow: labor and tillage of the soil
  - b. Owl: representing wisdom
  - c. **Rising sun:** representing progress
  - d. **Cross section ear of corn:** as a symbol of unity, as corn is grown in every state of the nation
  - e. American eagle: represents our national freedom

64. The five degrees of membership shall be:

a. Discovery Degree wears the blue pin

b. Greenhand Degree wears bronze emblem pin
c. Chapter FFA Degree wears silver emblem pin
d. State FFA Degree wears gold emblem charm
e. American FFA Degree wears gold emblem key

- 65. The State Leadership Conference (SLC) is the annual meeting of the Idaho FFA Association. The Idaho Leadership Conference must be held at least 45 days prior to the meeting of the National Convention of the FFA.
- 66. The three standing committees of the Idaho FFA Association are:

  - b. Audit and Budget committee
  - c. Program of Activities and Resolution committee
